

DOMELANES HORSESHOE RULES 2010

1. Each team shall consist of two players. Subs may be used when one player is absent. But each team must still pay \$10 weekly. **NO PAY – NO PLAY!!!**
2. Two dollars of each teams fees weekly will be designated toward end of the year prize money to be awarded according to league standings. In case of a tie, a team must win 2 out of three games to win. Trophies will be awarded to the winners of the end of the year tournament.
3. All matches, consisting of 3 games, will be played on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 or 7:30 PM at the Dome Lanes.
4. All players must fill out a liability waiver.
5. The League will run 12 weeks long, with a double elimination tournament held for the next two weeks following the league, Aug. 11th and 18th, beginning at 6 PM.
6. An end of the season party will be held August 25th, 2010.
7. There will be a cocktail hour at 8 p.m. July 7 and another during the end of season party on Aug. 25th at 6:30 p.m.
8. All shoes are to be pitched from the pitching platforms with women being allowed a grace distance of 3 feet.
9. Each game will begin with the flip of a coin. The winner will have choice of pits, and then will alternate each game.
10. Each player will deliver both shoes, one at a time, and then the other player shall deliver their shoes. A player may deliver the shoes from either the left or right platform, but in any one turn, both shoes must be delivered from the same side. A player shall pitch the entire game with the same hand, except in the case of a medical emergency.
11. Each game will be played to 21. You must win by 2 points or be the first to get 23.
12. A Ringer, a shoe which comes to rest encircling the stake, is worth 3 points. A straightedge touching both points of the heel of the shoe must clear (not touch) the stake in order to be declared a ringer.
13. A Leaner, a shoe which comes to rest on the stake, is worth 2 points.
14. A Shoe in Count, a shoe which lands within 6 inches of any part of the stake, is worth 1 point.
15. Any shoes that lands further than 6 inches from the stake has no value.
16. Any shoe that first hits outside of the pit or hits the wood at any time and then lands inside the pit cannot count for a point and has to be removed before the next shoe is thrown.
17. The scoring method used will be **CANCELLATION SCORING!!!**
In Cancellation Scoring, only one contestant can score in each inning.
 - Ringers cancel each other. A ringer of one player shall cancel a ringer of the other team.
 - If no ringers are made, a Leaner would then be the top score with 2 points.
 - If no ringers or Leaners, the closest shoes in count will count.
18. During the last four weeks of the season, a team may use a sub, only if the sub is approved by the majority of the teams.
